

## **Skill Mix for Preceptorship**

## **OVERARCHING AIMS**

All NQPs will have a <u>named</u>
<u>Preceptor</u> regardless of who they are working with.

During the first 14 shifts there will be no solo response required from the Preceptee.

Whilst the aim is for an NQP to be provided with a Band 6 paramedic to work with at their base location, this may not always be possible and an NQP may be required to travel to a main station within the county.

NQP 2 (12-24 months)	*	In the circumstances whereby a Band 6 clinician cannot be identified to work with the preceptee for all the 14 shifts. The preceptee will still have a named preceptor who should check in with them at regular intervals.  The LP L&D team should be aware of this and support the progress closely.	
NQP 1 (6-12 months)	**		
HALO/SP shift/Part of a three-person crew with a Band 6 clinician	***		
NQP Preceptee (0-6 months)		This skill mix would <b>not</b> count
