

Skill Mix for NQP Preceptorship

OVERARCHING AIMS

All NQPs will have a <u>named</u> <u>Preceptor</u> regardless of who they are working with.

During the first 14 shifts there will be no solo response required from the Preceptee.

Whilst the aim is for an NQP to be provided with a Band 6 paramedic to work with at their base location, this may not always be possible and an NQP may be required to travel to a main station within the county.
