As I'm sure you are aware safeguarding is a pillar of effective and safe practice in healthcare. With this in mind and considering the guidance from Working Together to Safeguard Children (2023), The Care Act (2014), and The Royal Collage of Nursing Intercollegiate Documents all clinical colleagues that interact with our patients need to be working at an enhanced level of safeguarding practice.

Safeguarding is a complex topic requiring a wide range of skills and knowledge to practice effectively. Given the intricacies of both adult and child safeguarding the intercollegiate recommendations are for education to be delivered by experts in the field. To achieve this the Trust has decided to use a virtual classroom platform to ensure that you can receive this education from members of the safeguarding team.

The content of the day is designed to both provide an update on contemporary safeguarding practice and allow you the chance to participate in an interactive classroom community that will support your learning and confidence.
